- Maximum 6 credit hours of the following travel-study courses may be applied toward the required 12 credit hours of art electives:
 - ARTC 45092 Field Experience Travel Study Crafts (1-3)
 - ARTF 44092 Field Experience Travel Study Fine Art (1-3)
- These courses may not be applied toward the required 18 credit hours of upper-division ARTF electives. Students may apply these courses toward fulfilling general electives, with no maximum credit hours required. These courses will fulfill the experiential learning requirement.

4. KBA 45080 may be used in the "art elective" category.
