- Maximum 6 credit hours of the following travel-study courses may be applied toward the required 12 credit hours of art electives:
 - ARTC 45092 Field Experience Travel Study Crafts (1-3)
 - o ARTF 44092 Field Experience Travel Study Fine Art (1-3)
- These courses may not be applied toward the required 18 credit hours of upper-division ARTF electives. Students may apply these courses toward fulfilling general electives, with no maximum credit hours required. These courses will fulfill the experiential learning requirement.
- 4. KBA 45080 may be used in the "art elective" category.
