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- 1. US 10097 is not required of transfer students with 25 credits (excluding College Credit Plus and dual-enrollment credit) or students age 21+ at time of admission
- 2. Number of credits required depends on meeting minimum 120 credit hours and minimum 39 upper-division credit hours. Maximum 12 credit hours may be used from the M.A. program for those students accepted into the combined B.S./M.A. program, see advisor.
- 3. A minimum C (2.000) grade must be earned to fulfill writing-intensive requirement.
- + Professional Phase coursework: A minimum 3.0000 cumulative GPA (after 60 hours) is required to be admitted into the professional phase of the major
