- 2. Number of credits required depends on meeting minimum 120 credit hours and minimum 39 upper-division credit hours. A business minor can be obtained with additional coursework (fulfilled with general elective hours) and GPA requirements. For students obtaining a minor: a minimum of 6 credit hours in the minor must be outside of the course requirements for any major or other minor the student is pursuing. Consult with advisor when choosing general electives.
- 3. A minimum C (2.000) grade must be earned to fulfill the writing-intensive requirement.
