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- 1. UC 10097 is not required of transfer students with 25 credits (excluding College Credit Plus and dual-enrollment credit) or students age 21+ at time of admission
- 2. Number of credits required depends on meeting minimum 120 credit hours and minimum 39 upper-division credit hours. Students are required to complete one of the following minors for graduation: Business, Finance, International Business for Non-Business Majors, Management for Non-Business Majors or Marketing. Consult advisor when choosing electives to fulfill minor requirement. A minimum of 6 credit hours in the minor must be outside of the course requirements for any major or other minor the student is pursuing. Consult with advisor when choosing general electives.
- 3. A minimum C (2.000) grade must be earned in either SPAD 35065 or SPAD 45030 to fulfill writing-intensive requirement.
