Students preparing for licensure in chemical dependency counseling should take HED 32530 or PSYC 41364 when choosing technical electives.
Students preparing to enroll in the BA in Psychology or Sociology should take psychology or sociology courses, respectively, when choosing technical electives.

3. Minimum internship hours 315 equivalent per semester; approval by the program director is required to register.
