Executive EPC Committee Member Proposal Questions

The role of the Executive EPC is to take an in-depth review of the proposals that are submitted to EPC. The members felt there were additional questions that needed to be asked, see below.

Sport, Exercise and Performance Psychology - B.S. Initial inquiry to establish a new major

See response document from the college to these questions.

- 1. Is $1\frac{1}{2}$ faculty enough to sustain the program?
- 2. What are the job opportunities with this bachelor's degree (apart from preparing for a master's)?
- 3. Is online-only the way to go for a bachelor's degree (i.e., missing campus experience, securing internships)?
- 4. What is the market need and demand for this as a bachelor's degree? (All certification in the field seems to require a master's degree.)
- 5. Does this program fit with the college's and the university's priorities?
- 6. Would an undergraduate minor, instead, fill the need?
- 7. Would you consider establishing this program at the master's level?
- 8. Do you have support for this new program from the Department of Psychological Sciences? (Proposal includes an email exchange from Jill Folk, undergraduate coordinator for the psychology majors, but no support letter from the department chair.)
- 9. Where is the compelling evidence that there is demand for this program above and beyond what the college already offers (e.g., Exercise Science, Sports Medicine, Sport Administration, Physical Education and Sport Performance)?

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
